

RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A POLICY FOR COUNTY PARTICIPATION IN
ROADWAY AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS: There is a desire on the part of the Board of County Commissioners for Larimer County to establish a formal policy stating the conditions under which Larimer County will participate in roadway and associated storm drainage improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Policy for Larimer County financial participation in roadway and associated storm drainage improvements will be as follows:

- 1) County Participation in Improvements To Subdivision Streets Which Are Not Presently County Maintained But Which Were Dedicated To The County as Public Rights-of-Way Prior to January 1, 1994

Larimer County will not participate in the initial cost of improvements to non-maintained subdivision streets. If, however, these streets are brought to County standards through a local improvement district or through some other means which does not require County participation, Larimer County will accept these streets for County maintenance and place them on the County maintained road system.

- 2) County Participation In Improvements To Existing County Maintained Subdivision Roads

In the event that existing County maintained subdivision streets deteriorate to the point where the majority of the residents of the area desire to improve the streets through the creation of a local improvement district, or some other means such as voluntary contributions, etc., Larimer County will contribute a dollar amount toward the cost of the improvement equal to 15% of the cost of an asphalt overlay placed on these streets. Larimer County will not participate in the cost of other improvements which may be needed to the streets, such as curb and gutter replacement, drainage structure replacement, etc.

- 3) County Participation in Minor Roadway and Storm Drainage Problems

With regard to minor roadway and drainage problems which may arise from time to time in a subdivision in which the streets are County maintained and the problem is impacting the County maintained street system, Larimer County will evaluate these problems on a case by case basis and determine to what extent, if any, Larimer County will participate in the cost of making needed improvements to either the street system or the storm drainage system.
